Application criteria

The CIJ Bursaries scheme is open to working and aspiring journalists from Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) background, who want to take part in the conference, but for financial reasons are unable to do so.

Selection criteria

The selection will be based on the applicants' track record of journalism/writing, so it is important to answer the questions in the Reasons for Applying section very carefully and give examples of your work.

Financial

The CIJ Bursary Fund has a limited amount of money to be spent on bursaries, so we will evaluate financial needs of each the candidate i.e. if you are able to cover some of the costs, associated with attending #CIJSummer, the CIJ Bursaries fund will cover the rest and the saved amount will go towards funding more people.

Other

Only successful candidates will be contacted. We are not able to respond to unsuccessful applications.
